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What Happens Next?

Where does my referral go once I send it?

Your referral goes to a Centralized Intake Team at FIREFLY.

What does Centralized Intake do with my request for service (referral)? Based on information you provide, the Centralized Intake Worker determines the most appropriate service(s) available for you/your child/youth in your community.

What if the Centralized Intake Team needs more information?

A Worker from the Centralized Intake Team will contact the caregiver/client by phone at the number provided to collect the information.

Are all the services from FIREFLY?

No. FIREFLY is only one of the service providers. You/your child/youth may also be referred to a partner organization such as Kenora Chiefs Advisory, Kenora Association for Community Living, the Northwestern Health Unit, Sioux Lookout First Nation Health Authority, Kenora-Rainy River Child and Family Services, and/or Child and Community Resources.

Can I request service from a specific Agency? Yes.

How does the Program/Agency that will provide the service get my information? Your information is shared through our secure record system with the Agency that will be providing the service.

How will I know what Agency is providing service?

You will be provided this information by telephone or email.

Will I hear directly from FIREFLY?

If you/your child/youth would be better served by one of our partner agencies, you will hear directly from that agency, not FIREFLY.
